Environmental and social review - June 2010

Achievements:

- Installation in April 2010 of two market leading WT15 wood waste energy heating systems which are fully compliant with the latest emission regulations and with a payback period of around 12 months. These systems burn waste wood (previously going to landfill) to heat the sawmill factory premises.
- Replacement of curtain-sided vehicle in March 2010 with an increased capacity vehicle resulting in larger loads per journey

Targets:

- Refurbishment of staff canteen area. Staff to be consulted regarding layout and equipment
- Monitor efficiency and suitability of wood waste energy heating system with a view to installing additional systems in two pallet factories.
- Upgrade and refurbishment of general office
- Review of external appearance of premises
